Rules and Procedures

WHO MAY APPLY:

Talented young flutists who are Seniors in High School and will be attending a University the following year. It is NOT required that the student be a music major. Applicants must be members of the IAF through their teacher, organizational membership or Friend of the Arts membership (extra 20.00 included with application fee). Students must live in the state of Indiana before the application is submitted.

Entry fee of \$20 by check made payable to IAF.

The applicant must complete the following by February 1:

1. Fill out application on Google Form:

2. Pay applicable fees to state treasurer. Make check payable to IAF. Mail check to: David Mannell, 1925 Central Ave. Indianapolis, IN 46202
3. Upload a copy of the musical scores on form. Please do not write your name in these scores.
4. Record and post (unlisted) the complete audition on YouTube. Please supply with your application the URL information if you post it on YouTube. (There is a place to paste the link in the google form.)

REPERTOIRE: There is no required list. Below is a list provided simply as an aid in choosing types of material to be performed as a guide in musical standards and technical difficulty. ISSMA Group 1 list selections may also be used.

Handel: Sonata No. 4, G Major
Ibert: *For Flute Only*
Quantz: Concerto Op. 100 (First Movement)
Kennan, Kent: Night Soliloquy
Chaminade: Concertino

- 1. Play two contrasting original compositions written for flute.**
- 2. It is not mandatory** for the audition repertoire to be memorized or accompanied.
- 3. Performance maximum time of 20 minutes.**

All paper-work will become the property of IAF and will not be returned. You will be contacted via email with results in a timely manner.

The Judge's decision for this award is final.
